Problems

- *real* state of knowledge and understanding about osprey and how humans affect the species is way higher than the knowledge codified and properly shared
- lack of coordination among players in assessing effects of all human influences on osprey in Labrador

Opportunities

- we've looked at many things that HAVE been accomplished, and some ideas are already out on some important new initiatives:
 - synthesis of Canadian data and knowledge
 - study of weather effects
 - fine-scale habitat characterization
 - release Brent from Hydro for a year to write up what he knows!
 - plus other ideas

Opportunities (cont'd)

- “too good to let go of!”
- fabulous opportunity to fulfill the dream and promise of *cumulative effects assessment!*
- need some sort of coordinated collaborative effort to continue research and monitoring of the Labrador osprey population in the face of continuing human activity in and development of the landscape
